As you have likely heard, there has been a noticeable increase in COVID cases recently in many parts of Alaska. This tricky virus is highly contagious and we're seeing more evidence of that as Alaskans move indoors due to colder temperatures. As COVID cases increase, so must our vigilance so that we can continue to stay on mission.

Those on the front lines who are unable to telework, keep up the crucial work you do for Alaska. <u>Just like the vests many wear for safety as a natural part of their work, a mask is worn to keep our crews safe and on the mission</u>.
